- Flexi Boarding option (Monday to Friday) for nearby students.
- Accommodation is available on campus for both boys and girls.

- Each hostel block has a capacity to house 12 students, is a villa like set up so that students feel a home-like environment.



The MYP is a challenging framework that encourages students to make practical connections between their studies and the real world. Students who complete the MYP are well-prepared to undertake the IB Diploma Programme (DP) or Career-related Programme (CP).

The MYP curriculum framework comprises eight subject groups, providing a broad and balanced education for early adolescents. The MYP requires at least 50 hours of teaching time for each subject group, in each year of the programme. In the final two years of the programme, carefully-defined subject group flexibility allows students to meet local requirements and personal learning goals.
